On Thursday April 6th, 1905 an article in the **DELTA PILOT**. read *"born in the thriving village of Delta, it is a bouncing babe, the idol of the community and has grown so rapidly that it is able to run at an enormous speed"*.

With the Reverend George Wellington Connors as the Editor-In-Chief, the **DELTA PILOT**. was distributed every Thursday between 1905 and 1908. The newspaper was printed in a King Street drive shed, which was opposite John Street, on a printing press that had been relocated from a defunct printing plant in Bancroft. The Paper was printed until March 27th, 1908.

Revived by the Lower Beverley Lake Park Management Board, the current version of the **DELTA PILOT**, which is now in its 10th year of printing, is produced through the support of Delta's Not-For-Profit and Charitable Organizations. Thank you for your support during the past decade.
